Battle's precisely drawn grids coalesce into penumbral form. In 2006's Time Piece (for Emma Kunz), the point of a cone emerges from thousands of intersecting pencil lines

into Euclidian luminescence. Lutz's thick oil paint conjures pungent vegetation and torpid creatures that coagulate into a chromatic loam at the bottom of her 30-inch-high canvases, the atmosphere above ripe with humid blues and smoggy pinks.
